DEFINITIONS:

"Quilting"

Quilting is made up of three layers - The front layer, the middle layer of batting etc and the backing.
The quilt is held together by hand or machine stitching.

"Machine Quilting"

Commercial is done by a paid machinist.

All quilts commercially quilted MUST be entered in class 29005 and will be ineligible for champion.

Non-Commercial is machine quilted by the person who made the quilt.

Entries & Exhibits must be at Showground by 8pm WEDNESDAY

Quilts and Wall Hangings MUST have a 10cm sleeve on reverse side NO SLEEVE, NO JUDGING
