PESTI VIRUS:

The Agricultural Societies Council of NSW recommend exhibitors to have a negative Pesti Virus certificate at the time of entry of any cattle to Show Competitions from January 1 2013

JOHNE'S DISEASE:

Cattle entries will be accepted from NJD MAP Assessed Herds and from Non-Assessed Herds. Separation requirements as determined by the Australian JOHNE'S Disease Market Assurance Program will apply at the show and all exhibitors must fill in an entry form.

CATTLE SCANNING:

Milton Show Society will strictly adhere to the NLIS policy that came into force from January 1 2006 as promulgated by the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW

LEADING OF BULLS:

The minimum age for leading bulls in the general beef classes is 12yrs of age as at the date of the show, unless otherwise stipulated.

All people restraining cattle shall be effectively trained and be able to do so.
