Beer judged according to: Colour - 3 points, Head - 6 points, Aroma - 6 points, Palate & Flavour - 18 points
= TOTAL:30 points.

Exhibits in each category should be presented for judging as follows:

Amateur Wine **1 x 750ml bottle for any wine entry in classes 11010 - 11030**
Minimum 1 x 330ml or 375ml bottle for any liqueurs or spirit entries in classes 11033 - 11035
(all bottles must be unlabelled or with covered label and without capsules)

Wine judged according to: Colour & Clarity - 3 points, Nose & Bouquet - 7 points, Palate & Flavour - 10 points
= TOTAL: 20 points.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. In these conditions, "Organiser" shall mean Milton Show Inc. "Entry" or "Exhibit" shall mean the beverages that are supplied for judging; an "Entrant" or "Exhibitor" is the person who supplies such beverages for judging.
2. Competition is open to all amateur home brew beer makers and amateur wine makers over the age of 18 years in the respective classes (unless the exhibit is non alcoholic)
3. Bottles will be tagged by the Organiser from the information provided on the Special Entry Form and allocated an entry number.
4. Labelled bottles will be concealed from the judges.
5. Entries become the property of the Organiser once they are accepted but may be returned to the respective Entrant at the discretion of the Chief Steward.
6. The Organiser does not accept responsibility for loss of or damage to any entry, entry form or fee and will not be held liable by any Entrant.
7. The acceptance of any Entry is at the discretion of the Organiser and any entry may be refused without any reasons for refusal being given.
8. The judges are persons nominated by the Organiser and the decision of the judges shall be final.
9. The judges reserve the right to remove to another class any Entry they deem to be out of class.
10. Special entry forms and Exhibits accompanied by entry fee are to be received at Vestibule located in Showground Lower Pavilion no later than 8pm on Wednesday.
11. The Chief Steward and any judges may disqualify an Entry if they consider it to be falsely represented.
12. All Exhibits must be entered according to the Categories and Styles published by the Australian Amateur Brewing Championships (AABC). See following page for overview of schedules. Judging will be according to style guidelines published by the AABC, which can be found on their website – www.aabc.org.au
13. All Entrants must indicate the Style of beer entered according to the AABC 2019 Schedule of Categories and Styles (include number and name, eg. 6.5 - Altbier).
14. The Champion Beer Award and the Champion Wine Award will be determined by the highest point score in classes 11001-11009 for Beer and in classes 11010-11035 for Amateur Wine entries.
15. The Most Successful Amateur Beer Award and Most Successful Amateur Wine Award will be determined by the Exhibitor who achieves the highest points from at least three (3) entries, each of which must be in different classes.
16. Any Entry receiving equal scores for any Award will be rejudged by the judges to determine the recipient of the Award.
